As we build up to Manotsava 2025, RNP, NIMHANS, and NCBS invite you to capture your idea of home through the lens of photography. Whether it's a place, a feeling, or a fleeting moment, show us where you belong.

Here's what to keep in mind:

Eligibility:

- Open to individuals aged 16 and above.
- Entries are welcome from both amateur and professional photographers.
- Each participant may submit only one photograph.
- Each photograph must be accompanied by a title (maximum 6 words) and a caption of (maximum 100 words) describing what this picture means to you with respect to a sense of belonging.

Technical Requirements:

- Only original photographs are accepted (no AI-generated or stock images).
- Black & white or filtered images are not permitted.
- Accepted file formats: JPEG or PNG.
- Minor colour correction is permitted.

The verification process requires:

- The original image file with EXIF data intact.
- A screenshot of the photo's details (metadata) from your phone or camera gallery, showing the date, time, location, and device used.

By participating in this contest, you confirm that:

- The submitted image must be original, created by you, and not generated using AI or copied from any other source.
- You retain the copyright to your image. It will be shared under a Creative Commons license, with permission granted to the festival to exhibit and publish it on online and offline platforms for non-commercial purposes.
- Any submission found to be plagiarised, AI-generated, or in violation of copyright laws will result in immediate disqualification and may lead to legal action.
- If the photograph includes visibly identifiable individuals, you must have obtained their consent for its display.
